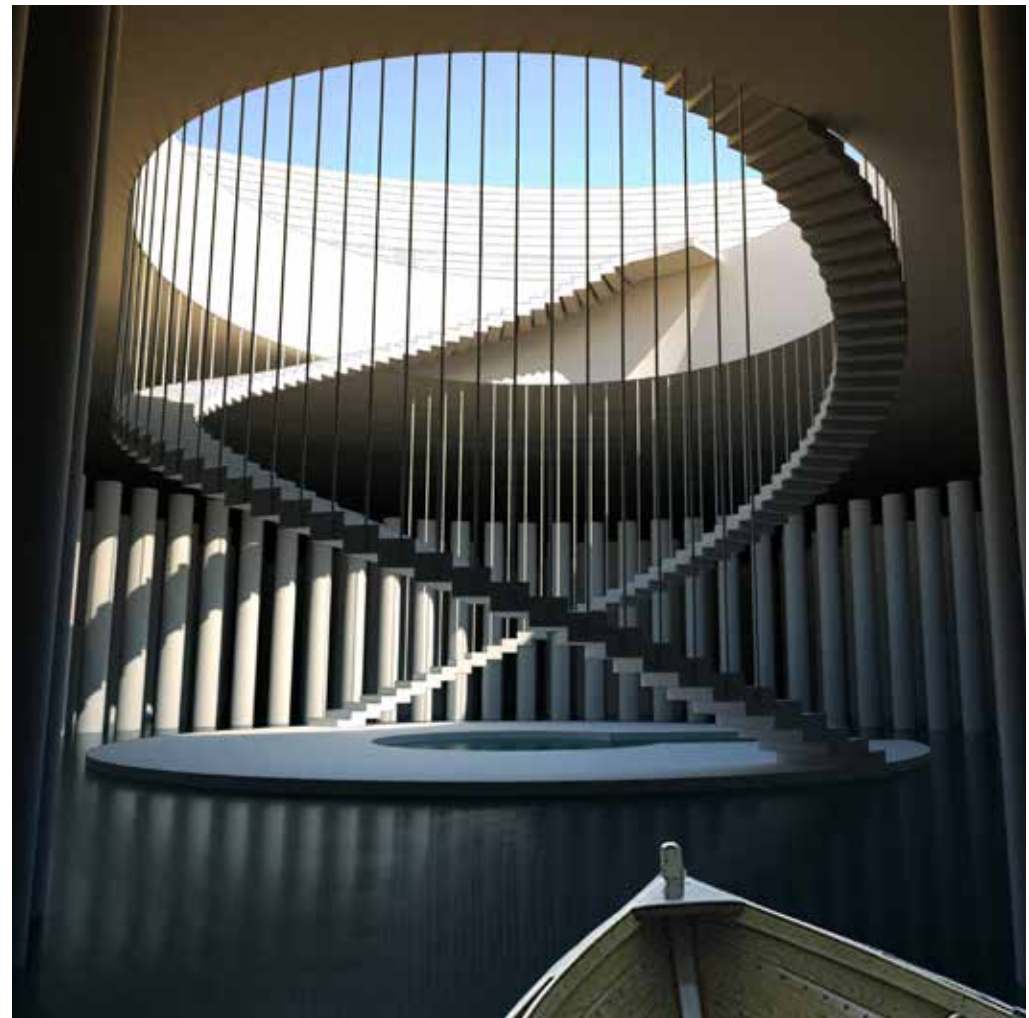
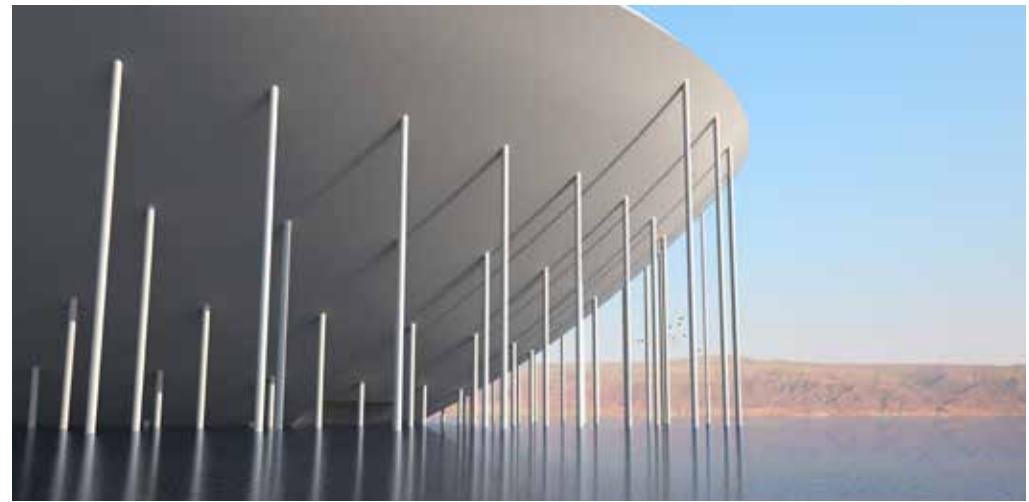


# YARAUVI (Unbuilt)

Location: Dead Sea

Yarauvi is a place where any person—regardless of nationality, race, religion, age or affluence—can be laid to rest. The Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth, holds significance as a historical space between cultures, both literally and figuratively.

The necropolis is a parabolic structure of concentric rings supported on a raft-like armature below the water line, which allows it to float in the buoyant salty waters of the Dead Sea. Inside, the necropolis is a bowl-shaped space open to the sky. Individual sarcophagi will progressively fill the stepped structure, laid out in a concentric configuration facing one another. By choosing this site as a final resting place, any citizen of the world can contribute to a growing monument to tolerance, reconciliation and unity.
